SPECIAL AWARDS CRITERIA

RULES TO BE OBSERVED

These awards are sponsored by Chamber of Commerce of West Alabama, Inc., and will be presented at the annual Northport Citizen of the Year banquet, which will be held annually at 7 p.m. on the first Tuesday in October.

Northport is a thriving and growing community, and many of its citizens are contributing toward this growth. The purpose of this award is to focus attention on achievements made by Northport citizens involved in making Northport a better community.

Nominees will be judged in answer to the primary question: "What outstanding contributions has the nominee made to benefit the general welfare or growth of Northport?"

Criteria for Nominations Are Outlined Below:

1. Nominations may be made by a civic, social, service, educational, business, or religious group located in Northport or by an individual who is a legal resident of Northport, Alabama, other than a member of the committee.
2. The Official Nomination Form supplied by the Chamber of Commerce of West Alabama, Inc., must be used; **all information must be typewritten.** (Extra pages may be added)
3. No more than two (2) letters of recommendation may accompany the nomination.
4. The nominee must be a legal resident of Northport for at least five years or must have a strong civic, social, service, educational, business, or religious connection within the Northport community.
5. The nominee must have made a significant contribution to the civic, social, educational, religious, business and/or community growth of Northport outside his/her related job or elected responsibilities.
6. The deadline for returning nominations to the Chamber of Commerce of West Alabama as established by the Northport Citizen of the Year committee will be strictly enforced.
7. The Committee, which is made up of prior recipients and/or members selected by the Northport Citizen of the Year committee, shall cast its vote by secret ballot. The results will not be announced until the night of the banquet. (A relative of a nominee serving on the Committee should not vote.)
8. A nominee cannot win a second time in the same classification but can be nominated to another category.
